It is unanimously resolved that –

1. As per notification by UGC(D.O. No.f.1.-2018(Journal/CARE), December, 2019), it has been decided that the Research and Publication Ethics(RPE) to be made compulsory in the syllabus of Ph. D. course work of each department. The eligible faculty members from other departments of the university may contribute in teaching of the said course.

2. BRS of the respective department will recommend the name of the joint/co supervisor, if required, and that will be forwarded to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for approval through the Research Coordinator.
3. If an existing supervisor resigns from the post of Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor/Principal of his/her university/college with lien or without lien and join another academic institute as stated, the incumbent will continue to act as supervisor of the candidate concerned to complete the Ph. D. work, though not exceeding the allotted time of six years.
4. The publication of the research article, as pre-requisite criteria of the submission of Ph.D. thesis, must be in a journal having ISSN or in a book having ISBN, peer reviewed as per the UGC norms. The publication may be in a UGC-approved journal and should not be in a paid journal; however, if any journal is enlisted in UGC, SCOPUS and WEB OF SCIENCE then this norm will not be followed.
