#### **SUB: OPENING OF ADMISSION PORTAL (2<sup>nd</sup> PHASE)**

As directed, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the admission portal of Sarsuna Law College will be opened for 2<sup>nd</sup> phase for admission in 3-year LL.B (Hons) Course for the academic year 2020-2021. The recommendation pertaining to admission related different issues are as follows:

#### **Choice Based Credit System:**

1. Choice Based Credit System will be maintained for the academic session 2020-2021.

#### **Procedure of Admission:**

1. Necessary **advertisement (2<sup>nd</sup> Phase)** for on-line admission to the 3-year LL.B (Hons) Course for the academic year 2020-2021 will be made by the University and communicate to the college for their own. Online admission for 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase will be made **w.e.f 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2020**. All the applicants will submit their application to the University Admission Portal. University will publish the merit list and send the same to the Sarsuna Law College. The college will complete the admission process according to the merit list. The University and college will provide helpline (Time specific) in their website in this regard.
2. The entire admission process should be made online.

3. Documents to be uploaded by the students while filling up the online application:
  - a. Admit card and Mark-sheet of Madhyamik Examination.
  - b. Mark-sheet of Higher Secondary Examination.
  - c. Mark-sheet of Graduation
  - d. Caste Certificate (where necessary).
  - e. PH Certificate (where necessary).

**Eligibility:**

1. Cut-off marks for General Category – 45% marks in Graduation (Any Stream)
2. Cut-off marks for OBC Category – 42% marks in Graduation (Any Stream)
3. Cut-off marks for SC and ST Category – 40% marks in Graduation (Any Stream)
4. Age Limit – No restrictions on Upper Age Limit

**N.B.:**

1. In case of equal marks in Graduation, total marks/percentage of marks of immediately preceding examination is to be taken into account for ranking.
2. Best five (5) of the H.S. Subjects must be adopted for calculating the total marks and percentage for H.S. Examination

**Intake: For remaining seats (27) only**
